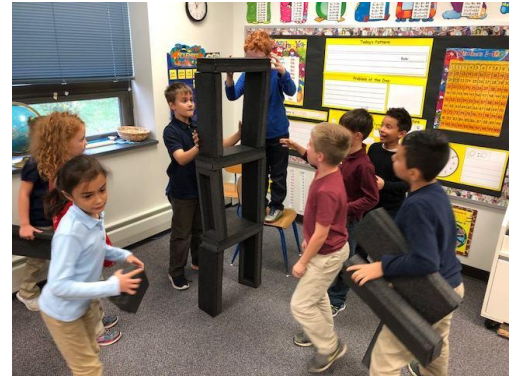
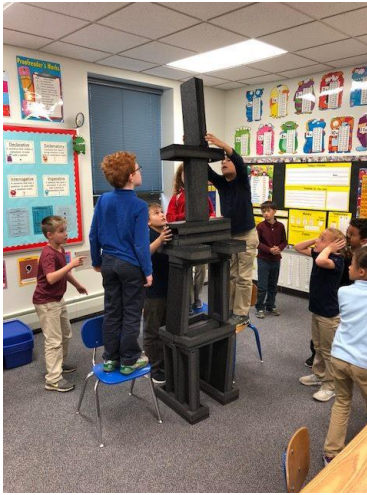


Integrated Learning

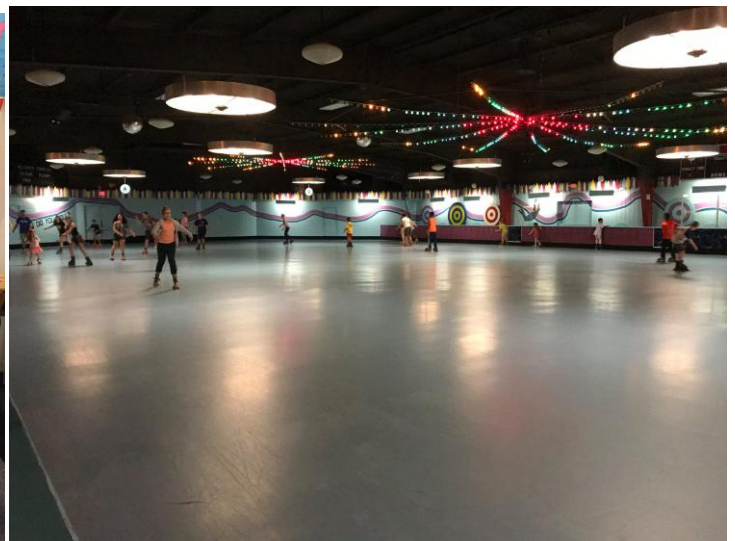
